**Show Entry Rules**  
**All Open Shows for 2011 Season**

Please make sure you are familiar with the attached Show Rules. These rules will be strictly enforced by the show committee.

1. The Show Committee reserves the rights to decide on any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error made or make any necessary alterations in the rules, prize list or program. Notice will be given to all exhibitors in the event of a change in the program, such as alterations and posted on the bulletin board.
2. **Completed entries must be received by May 13 2011.** Entries received after this date and prior to the show will be charged a late entry penalty of \$20.00. Classes added to your entry after the show has started are considered ***post entries*** and charged the post entry fees. No telephone entries will be accepted. The proper entry form must be filled out and ***signed*** or the entry will not be accepted. ***If you have your own back number please put your number on the entry form.***
3. **Post entries** must be made and paid for **no later** than 2 classes before the class is held. **Stake Classes** will be **no later** than 2 classes as well and money for stake class will be given out at the end of the day. This will be strictly enforced by the Show Secretary.
4. Entries may be **faxed or emailed** to the Show Secretary without payment attached; however, your entry will **not be officially accepted until payment in full** has been made.
5. Exhibitors canceling their entries after 9:00 p.m. Friday night prior to Shows shall forfeit all their entry and stall fees **EXCEPT** on receipt of an official certificate or letter of disability from a qualified Veterinarian (in case of a horse's withdrawal) or a qualified Doctor (in case of a rider's withdrawal). Receipts of such documents must be made to the Show Secretary either prior to the show starting date or within 48 hours of the close of the show. If any refund is made, **20% of all fees will be retained as office charges.** Once a vet scratch has been received by the office, the horse may not be re-entered in the show.
6. **Posting of Patterns/Courses or Special Instructions.**  
All patterns, courses or special instructions for classes requiring such shall be posted at least one hour before schedule time of class. Patterns will be in packages as well.
7. **No 2 year old of any breed** may be shown in **any performance** class prior to July 1<sup>st</sup> of its 2-year old year. **THIS WILL BE STRICKLEY ENFORCED.**

8. **Green Horse/Rider Walk/ Trot/Jog Division** are open to Horses or Riders that are in their **1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing**. No trainers, coaches or experience show persons can enter this class. Horses entered in this Division or Classes **will not be allowed in any other classes in the Open Show** other than showmanship and halter **unless ridden by another exhibitor**.
9. **Open Training Walk/Jog/Trot** is open to trainers, coaches and experience riders only. Horses entered in these Classes **will not be allowed in any other classes in the Open Show** other than showmanship and halter unless ridden by another exhibitor. No two year olds will be allowed in this class. This class will pay out half the entry to exhibitors to 3<sup>rd</sup> place and there will be no ribbons.
10. There will be a **5 second penalty** for each **barrel or pole** that is **knocked over** plus **one hat warning**. If hat is lost the 2<sup>nd</sup> time it will be disqualification.
11. **Helmets must be worn by all youth (18 and under)** when they are on the show grounds. This **includes all areas** on the grounds as well as the show ring.  
  
**Youth-** Rider must be 18 years of age or under as of Jan 1/2011  
**Sr –** Rider must be 19 years of age or older as of Jan 1/2011
  - a) **Proper** English or Western **Attire** must be worn for classes entered.
  - b) Riders **will be responsible to be ready** when your class is called.
  - c) **Stallions** must be shown by **senior exhibitors**, 19 year or older

**.STABLING:**

- a) All stalls will be assigned on a first come basis. All show entries arriving by mail will be considered first come basis and horse names will be put on stalls by Grounds Co-coordinator. All exhibitors will be required to pay a stall fee. No horses to be shown from horse trailers due to liability issues.
- b) **Exhibitors will not** move from their assigned stalls without permission of the Grounds Co-coordinator. While all stalls have been inspected for safety of horses, the Show Committee strongly urges each exhibitor to personally inspect stalls before stabling. Any problems or concerns must be taken up with the Grounds Co-coordinator.
- c) **Stall fees are** \$40.00 for a box; \$50.00 enclosed box stall, \$25.00 for a straight for the weekend. Tack stalls will be charged at \$25.00/weekend for straight stalls and only if available.
- d) Exhibitors may move into their stalls on **Friday of the show weekend** anytime after lunch and are required to leave the stalls by Sunday after the show ends.

- e) **It is required that all stalls be cleaned prior to leaving the show grounds.**  
Stalls, tack stalls and alley way must be left clean and free of any garbage at end of show. A charge of **\$30.00** will be levied to any exhibitor that leaves a dirty stall. **The Show Committee will strictly enforce this rule. If this becomes a practice with any one exhibitor, the Show Committee will take further action.**
- f) Hay, feed and bedding **ARE NOT** available on the grounds.
- h) Anyone traveling in a **camper or trailer** can park on the grounds in the camping areas provided. **Sites with 2-way (\$35.00) and 3-way (\$45.00)** hookups are available and payment must be included with your entry.
- i) **Alcohol and substance abuse is strictly prohibited.** The Show Committee reminds all exhibitors that this is a family orientated show with young children and youth present at all times.
- j) **NO SMOKING IN AND AROUND THE BARN AREAS.**

**The Show Committee may cancel or combine any classes** that do not have 3 entries.

k) **Judges decision is final**

l) The Open show will be **single judged** with alternating judges on Saturday (Halter and English) and Sunday (Western and Games).

a) **Ribbons** will be awarded to **fifth place except** Green Training which will have no ribbons award.

b) **Payouts for Regular and Stake Classes** are as follows

**Regular classes** 1<sup>st</sup> \$10.20, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$7.50, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$6.30, 4<sup>th</sup> \$4.50, 5<sup>th</sup> \$1.50

**Stake class** 1<sup>st</sup> 30%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20%, 4<sup>th</sup> 15%, 5<sup>th</sup> 10%

c) Green Training Class payout will be half the entries taken in and split to 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
